Description of Entity's Outcomes

The Birkenhead Town Centre Association Inc. is an incorporated society registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 on 19 October 2004.

The Birkenhead Town Centre Association Inc. is a not-for-profit organisation that aims to develop and enhance business in the Birkenhead Town Centre.

The objects of the Association are:

1. To assist and guide the development and advancement of the commercial interests of business people and businesses in the Birkenhead Village commercial district through a co-ordinated, structured and measurable communications, branding, marketing and economic development programme.

2. To foster and promote generally the welfare of the business community of Birkenhead Village commercial district and in particular to provide a forum for networking and collaboration of members and sharing of information.

3. To improve the environment of the Birkenhead Village Commercial District so as to attract and retain business in order to drive employment and economic growth.

4. To capitalize on the unique assets and profile of the Birkenhead Village commercial district use that as a means of establishing an identity and positioning for the area.

5. To make arrangements with and/or advocate to the Government, Local authorities and/or persons, council controlled organisations, other corporations or associations for the improvement of amenity, streetscapes, utilities, transport, services or other infrastructure, and for lighting, surfacing, security and cleaning to the benefit of the Birkenhead Village Commercial District.

Statement of Accounting Policies

Birkenhead Town Centre Association Incorporated For the year ended 30 June 2024

'How did we do our accounting?'

Basis of Preparation

The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Revenue Recognition

Funding is received from the Auckland Council by way of targeted rates charged to businesses in the Birkenhead Town Centre. Payments are received on a quarterly basis.

Funding is also received for events by way of Grants. Grants received are recognised as revenue unless specific conditions attach to a grant and repayment of the grant is required where these conditions are not met. In these cases, the grant is treated as a liability until the conditions are met.

Interest is recognised when it is earned.

Donations are recognised when they are received.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The entity is registered for GST. All amounts are stated exclusive of goods and services tax (GST) except for accounts payable and accounts receivable which are stated inclusive of GST.

Income Tax

Birkenhead Town Centre Association Incorporated is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. Policies have been applied on a consistent basis with those of the previous reporting period.
